

Autumn Meeting, Friday 27th September – Sunday 29th September 2019
Cedar Court Hotel, Mayo Avenue, Rooley Lane, Bradford, BD5 8HW

Our Autumn weekend is based at the 4-star Cedar Court Hotel, easily accessible by motorway and well placed to enjoy both the industrial heritage and beautiful scenery of this part of the country. We are putting in place arrangements to feature musical boxes, organettes, ever popular steam trains, and more. In addition to the traditional offering of mechanical music presentations, 'bring and tell', a highly entertaining (as well as informative) look at organettes, we will also sample the delights of the Keighley and Worth Valley Railway, with a prolonged stop at Ingrow West station to allow a visit to the two museums there. ('You don't have to be a railway enthusiast to enjoy the delights of this museum.') Also on the programme is a visit to the Bankfield Museum in Halifax, home of a number of musical boxes, (one working on display), with collections and exhibitions about the local history, including a one about the area in World War II. The Society package includes two nights bed and breakfast, buffet supper on Friday and three-course private formal dinner on Saturday, train ticket, museum entrance fees, and light lunch Sunday. Cost per person: £155 (double/twin occupancy); £165 single.

Please note: there is an additional charge for **on-site hotel parking (£3 per car, per 18 hours)** – make sure you enter your car reg number on arrival! – and Saturday lunch is **not** included. (Low cost snacks available at KWVR.) There is a lot to see and do in the area, especially if you are interested in industrial heritage, literature, or the wild scenery, so you may want to plan to extend your stay.
